

January 10, 2011  
City Council Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Staner. Council members Boffeli, Henry, Knepper, Moriarity and Soppe answered roll call. Motion Boffeli, 2<sup>nd</sup> Moriarity to approve the agenda – all ayes. There were no speakers from the floor.

Motion Soppe, 2<sup>nd</sup> Henry to file meeting minutes of the Park Board – all ayes.

Steve Thompson with MSA Professionals gave a presentation of possible upgrades to the City's water system & towers. Council will review the information and make a decision on what options would be best for the City at the next Council meeting.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Soppe to go forward with the recommendation of the Sidewalk Committee to construct a trail walk along 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue from the Fire Station to the grocery store as long as 80% of the project cost is received through a Transportation Enhancement Grant through ECIA – all ayes.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Boffeli to approve Resolution 1-11 making annual appointments for the City of Cascade for calendar year 2011. Moriarity, Henry, Boffeli, ayes – Knepper, Soppe, nay.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Soppe to modify the City's snow parking ordinance to read such that parking would be allowed on the odd numbered side of streets on odd numbered days of the month and same for even side of the streets on even days from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and place signs along 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue to read the same – all ayes.

Council discussed ideas for facilitating and encouraging additional residential and business development in Cascade with local incentives. Motion Moriarity, 2<sup>nd</sup> Henry to table until the next Council meeting for further review and discussion – all ayes.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Boffeli to approve a Class B beer permit with outdoor service area and Sunday sales for the Cascade Maid Rite, 325 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W – all ayes.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Boffeli to approve the City's January bills, the 12/28/10 Council minutes and the December Treasurer's Report and Fund Balance Report – all ayes.

Motion Boffeli, 2<sup>nd</sup> Henry to file correspondence – all ayes.

Police Chief Heim reviewed the Police Report. Council members again questioned the reason for the police car to be running when it is sitting out front of the office and why a parking ticket was given on Harrison St SE when there are no signs posted in the area the ticket was given. Heim asked when the car was running and explained that it may have something to do with keeping the car warm since it has not had heat and that the ticket in question was already waived. Mayor Staner announced that no more tickets would be issued in that area until signs are in place.

City Administrator Lansing reported a water main break on 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave SW over the weekend had been fixed today. Lansing reported that another 50 ton of salt was ordered and should be here this week.

Motion Henry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Boffeli to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. – all ayes.
