

Park Board Meeting Minutes
April 2, 2018

The April 2, 2018 Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Board Member Curry at 6:00 p.m. Board members Terry “Cookie” Rausch, Brad Boffeli and Daren Manternach were present. Chairman Slim Boyle was absent.

Motion by Rausch, second by Boffeli to approve the agenda – all ayes.

Motion by Boffeli, second by Rausch to approve the meeting minutes from February 5, 2018– all ayes.

The Board reviewed the February and March month end financials for the park and pool. Motion by Manternach, second by Rausch to approve the financials – all ayes.

At the last meeting in other business, Chairman Boyle had mentioned that Bill McCarthy would be interested in pruning and thinning out the trees in the proposed Oak Hill Park area. This couldn't be formally acted on since it was not an agenda item. The Park Board discussed and felt this was necessary. Motion by Rausch, second by Manternach to have Bill McCarthy prune and thin out the trees in the Oak Hill Park area with a cap of \$300.00 – all ayes.

Terry and Jan Frasher addressed the Board about the pickle ball court. They had been gone over the winter and wanted to know what was happening with this. The City Administrator told them that the Council had put in the budget to redo the tennis courts with adding pickle ball lines and to do new pickle ball courts next year. In connection with this, the Council would like a representative from the Park Board to attend their next meeting to discuss what they want with the new tennis court and to also discuss the pickle ball court. Rausch and Manternach will make sure one of them attends the next City Council meeting, which is April 9th.

Additionally, the City Administrator told the board about a grant opportunity for getting \$20,000 for our parks. It requires people to vote for Cascade. The information will be shared on our website, Facebook and local access channel. A notice will also be put in the paper. Voting is through April 30.

With nothing further, motion by Boffeli, second by Manternach to adjourn the meeting at 6:16p.m. – all ayes.
