

Park Board Meeting Minutes  
August 6, 2018

The August 6, 2018 Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Boyle at 5:00 p.m. Board members Brad Boffeli, Terry "Cookie" Rausch and Dave Curry were present. Board member Manternach was absent.

Motion by Curry, second by Rausch to approve the agenda – all ayes.

Motion by Curry, second by Rausch to approve the meeting minutes from July 2, 2018– all ayes.

The Board reviewed the July month end financials for the park and pool.

The board discussed taping out the gym in City Hall for pickle ball so the players can use it in the winter. Many people who play pickle ball migrate to a warmer climate in the winter. But there are those who might still want to play pickle ball. The only concern was that the gym floor not get scratched by the legs of the net. We can try it for a winter and see what happens. The pickle ball players will have to use the gym during the day because after school gets out it is busy every day with activities. Motion by Raucsh, second by Boffeli to approve purchasing a net for pickle ball and taping it out in the gym – all ayes.

The Board meeting then continued at the proposed location of the Oak Hill Park. The Board discussed a layout for the park. A shelter/restroom building would be nice to set between the two big trees and then place some playground equipment near this. We will need to place a fence around the retention pond. On the more East end of the area might be a good area for a disc golf area. The most west end would be a good area for a dog park. We will need to place a double wide road into the area with a turnaround. The trees also need to be thinned out. At the west end a walking/biking trail to Industrial Street. Mike Beck has offered to provide the rock, if the City would seal coat this area. The problem is the City doesn't own this. The City will talk to Mike to see about an easement for the trail.

With nothing further, motion by Boffeli, second by Curry to adjourn the meeting at 5:36p.m. – all ayes.
