

Park Board Meeting Minutes
January 12, 2017

The January 12, 2017 Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Board Chairman Boyle at 5:00 p.m. Board Members Dave Curry, Slim Boyle, Daren Manternach and Terry “Cookie” Rausch were present. Brad Boffeli was absent. Also present was City Administrator, Deanna McCusker.

Motion by Rausch, second by Manternach to approve the agenda – all ayes.

Motion by Curry, second by Rausch to approve the meeting minutes from December 5, 2016– all ayes.

Board members received financial reports for the park and the pool for December.

Two members of the Youth board addressed the Park Board concerning the purchase of a new scoreboard for the ball diamond at the Community Park. The existing one hasn’t worked in years so the spectators don’t know the score during the games. They asked the high school where they purchased their sign from and contacted the company and received an estimated cost of \$4,000 for a new board. It was mentioned about a cost share. The new scoreboard will mount on the same beams as the old one. The only other cost might be for an electrician to get it hooked up. The youth board will get a hard cost and see about the cost share and come back to the next meeting. Motion by Curry, second by Rausch to table the scoreboard discussion until the February meeting- all ayes.

The Youth Board also wanted to know if it would be acceptable to expand the field. The 7th grade league needs the field to be back further about 15’. Then the field would move back for the other leagues. This would be of no expense to the City. Motion by Rausch, second by Curry to allow the field to be expanded – all ayes.

The board discussed the upcoming pool season. It was discussed keeping the staffing the same as last year. It was also discussed about private lessons and how the money is handled. Motion by Curry, second by Rausch to have private lessons handled by the guards entirely – all ayes.

Motion by Rausch, second by Curry to adjourn the meeting at 5:22 p.m. – all ayes.
