

Park Board Meeting Minutes  
July 10, 2017

The July 10, 2017 Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Boyle at 5:00 p.m. Board members Terry "Cookie" Rausch, Dave Curry and Brad Boffeli were present. Daren Manternach was absent. Also present was City Administrator, Deanna McCusker and Angie Link and Brian Wolken, representing people interested in disc golf.

Motion by Rausch, second by Curry to approve the agenda – all ayes.

Motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to approve the meeting minutes from June 5, 2017– all ayes.

Board members received financial reports for the park and the pool for June.

Angie Link from Cascade and Brian Wolken, a Monticello City Council member was present to discuss implementing a disc golf course in Cascade. Angie had started a petition to see if there was an interest for disc golf on Facebook. The petition received over 186 signatures in 2 weeks. Many people from other communities would travel to Cascade if we had a disc golf course. If Cascade would start a course, we could be part of a disc golf league. Monticello has an 18 hole disc golf course. It cost \$15,000 the first year to get it up and going. The 2<sup>nd</sup> year it was \$10,000, which was mostly maintenance. The location for the course in Monticello is 14 acres. In Cascade, there had been a course at the Community Park. It was also discussed about partnering with the campground on this. A board member said he would rather have it in the City. To decrease the cost to get started, businesses could pay for a hole and then their name would be by the hole. Also, we could see if Bard would donate some concrete. There are no charges to the patrons, but sometimes there are donation boxes. We would do a 9 hole course and it would probably cost \$10,000 to get started. The Board asked if Angie could design a course at the Community Park and talk to some businesses to see if they would donate a hole and revisit this at the August meeting. Motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to table the disc golf discussion until the August meeting – all ayes.

The Board again discussed the bleacher situation down at the Community Park. The board was presented with some different options. They would like the top seating row to be 7-8' off the ground and have 5-6 rows of seating. They would also love to have some shade cover. After discussing for a short time, the Board decided they would like to research the idea of making bleachers fit what they want. The City Administrator will work with the engineer to design. Motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to work with the engineer to design a bleacher – all ayes.

The Board received information on the pool committee's recommendation on moving forward with replacing the old pool. They are in acceptance of the project moving forward.

With nothing further, motion by Rausch, second by Curry to adjourn the meeting at 5:35p.m. – all ayes.
