

Park Board Meeting Minutes
October 2, 2017

The October 2, 2017 Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Boyle at 5:00 p.m. Board members Terry "Cookie" Rausch, Brad Boffeli, and Dave Curry were present. Daren Manternach was absent. Also present was City Administrator, Deanna McCusker.

Motion by Rausch, second by Curry to approve the agenda – all ayes.

Motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to approve the meeting minutes from September 6, 2017– all ayes.

The Board reviewed the September month end financials for the park and pool.

The bleachers at the Community Park were again discussed. The City Administrator received quotes from 3 different companies for bleachers. One quote was received from Kay Park for \$12,567; another was from American Aluminum Seating for \$12,932 and Boland Recreation for \$15,155. All the quotes include the bleachers, freight and professional installation. These bleachers are higher and longer and will hold around 123 people. These will be placed behind home plate and then the areas to the right and left of the bleachers will be for chairs. It was discussed purchasing from Kay Park and asking if they would accept \$12,000, since the City has purchased from them in the past. Motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to approve purchasing bleachers from Kay Park and to see if they would accept \$12,000 instead of \$12,567 and if acceptable purchase them – all ayes. The old bleachers will be relocated to the soccer fields if agreeable.

The Board needs to begin working on their vision plan for the park. This includes a short-term plan and then a 5, 10 and beyond plan. Some items discussed include upgrading the tennis courts, making a pickle ball court, upgrading playground equipment, extending walking trails, putting bike lanes along the Farley road. At the next meeting a list that was developed by the Hometown Pride Committee will be reviewed.

With nothing further, motion by Curry, second by Boffeli to adjourn the meeting at 5:20p.m. – all ayes.
