Updated Floodplain Maps Available for Review

The Iowa Dept. of Natural Resources and FEMA will host an Open House on Wednesday, Oct 17th from 6:00PM – 8:00PM at the National Education Center for Ag Safety in Building 3 (on the NICC Campus), located at 8342 NICC Dr in Peosta. The Open House will allow citizens the opportunity to learn about their potential change in flood risk and to discuss flood insurance options.

Flood risk can change over time, and Dubuque County's preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Map shows how the flood risk has changed in your community. The preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Dubuque County were issued to all cities across the county for review and comment on August 27th.

The preliminary floodplain maps provide detailed, property-specific flood risk information to help residents, business owners, and community officials better understand their flood risk, and make informed decisions about reducing flood risk and purchasing flood insurance. The maps are currently available for review on FEMA's Flood Map Service Center website at <https://msc.fema.gov> and at www.iowafloodmaps.org.
