### 2 COUNCIL SEATS

One of the most challenging and exciting responsibilities an individual can assume is to become a council member or mayor. The business of city government and local leadership presents a unique opportunity to resolve issues, accomplish goals, and affect the future of your community.

The City of Cascade conducts business on the second and fourth Monday of each month at 6:00p.m. with additional work sessions during budget season (December – February) and special meetings when necessary. Council members are assigned to various committees.

*Two Council seats on the ballot - four year term.*

*One Mayor seat on the ballot - two year term.*

*Voting 7:00am-8:00pm*

*Dubuque County Residents ~ City Hall Council Chambers, 320 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W.*

*Jones County Residents ~ Cascade EMS Center, 803 1<sup>st</sup> Ave W.*

In order to hold office in the City, a candidate must be an eligible elector, meeting the same qualifications required to vote, and be a resident of the City.

Nomination papers can be obtained at the City Clerk's office, the Dubuque County Auditor's office as well as [www.dubuquecounty.org](http://www.dubuquecounty.org). Nominees must obtain at least ten (10) eligible signatures and submit the Affidavit of Candidacy. Candidate filing begins Monday, August 26, 2019 and ends with papers due at Cascade City Hall by 5:00 p.m. Thursday, September 19, 2019.
