



- Sewer jetting was completed on Wednesday, August 27. No issues were found.
- The library grass was redone last week. A watering system is in place to make sure it is getting watered enough.
- Samie and I had an hour-long review with Tyler, the new software company to review our payroll system and reports that we run.
- Our current phone system through Cascade Communications is no longer being supported since it has been identified as end of life. We will be moving to a new Hosted Business Solution phone system. We will be getting new phones for city hall. All 4 of us at city hall could be on a phone call at the same time with the new system. Headsets can be used with the phone system. We are working on all the specifications to make sure we have everything covered and then we will be making the switch.

- The pool will be repainted next week.
- I am doing a cash flow analysis for the wastewater plant to review current rates and to determine what we should increase it to.
