RE: Park Shelters with Restrooms at Oak Hill Park and Shade Structure at Pickleball Courts

From: Deanna McCusker, City Administrator

- The basic restroom is a basic, two-stall structure. 10'x18' estimate \$100,000
- Prairie Creek in Maquoketa is a 40'x 86'structure with kitchenette and overhead doors to create an "open" pavilion. Cost was \$450,000. They ran their project through a nonprofit and worked with the lumber yard in Maquoketa to get all the prices for each component of the project
- Vista Park in Kalona is a 25'x 34' structure. Two level construction with a dog wash and garden shed and multiple restrooms. Cost was \$550,000.
- Gateway Park in Monona is a 28' x 20' structure. They also worked with a local building supply company to draw plans, solicit quotes. Cost was \$75,000 in 2019 so well over \$100,000 now.

What does the park board and community want to see in the Oak Hill park for a pavilion and restrooms?

Options for funding a project like this:

- We could apply for a CAT grant. Up to \$250,000 with equal match
- Go through the lumber company to design the building and help with getting quotes
- Establish a "Friends of the Parks" to coordinate the project. The project would not have to be publicly bid or engineered. This would save money.

Or is there another part of the Oak Hill Park that is a higher priority than a pavilion with restrooms? We could do a combination project: pavilion with restrooms and trail.

The Pickleball group is also interested in placing a shade structure shelter near the pickleball courts. An estimate of cost for the shade structure is \$40,000. They will bring a design and cost estimate to the meeting.



### Shown with 2 Individual stalls















